LIFE SKILL TARGET: HOLIDAY MEAL PLANNING

Cooking and meal planning can be a great way to connect, especially during the holiday season. Instead of making all the meals yourself, include your teens in meal prep, cooking and cleanup. Share the cookbooks and online resources you use for recipes and meal ideas. Ask them to find a recipe they'd like to make, and coach them through making it.

#### Why it matters:

Developing a cooking repertoire increases self-awareness, decision-making and relationship building. Learning these life skills allows youth to contribute to the household in personalized and independent ways.

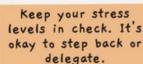

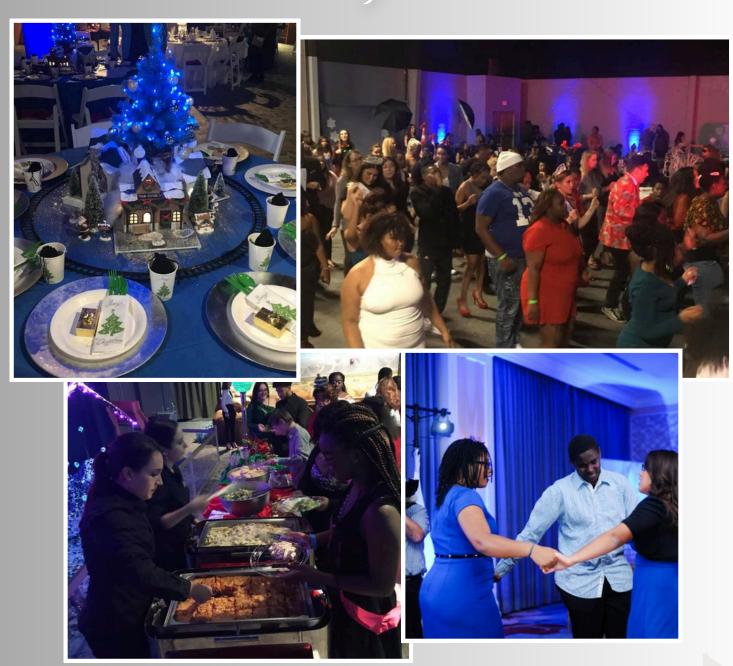
